- 1. Worship: In addition to the Sunday Worship service, the Coordinator of Music Ministry will organize organ/piano, brass and contemporary band music for scheduled services in the liturgical calendar. The coordinator will also organize music for worship and events held at the Kierch (the original historic church).
- 2. Music Programs: The coordinator will have the responsibility for leadership and development of the music program. There are opportunities to develop creative choirs and other groups that encourage people in the congregation and community to participate in the music ministry during worship and in other church and community events.
- **3. Worship Planning:** The coordinator will collaborate with the Pastor, staff and congregational leaders for general planning and leadership of the congregation's worship music.
- **4. Weddings and Funerals:** The coordinator when available, will perform for weddings and funerals within the Church.
- **5. Music and Instruments:** The coordinator will be responsible for the well being/care for the music library and all church owned musical instruments.
